STORM DRAINAGE PROJECT UPDATE

This work will need to be inspected before the work can proceed. They will start working at the Park at the end of November then move to Carrollwood Meadows Drive for the major part of the project.

We look forward to the completion of this long-awaited project and will give an update in the January newsletter.




